

## Duke Seeks Two Senior Managers in Law Enforcement

Duke University is ranked among the best institutions in the country, has been named a best place to work by publications and organizations, including Carolina Parent, Computerworld, The Chronicle of Higher Education and the American Association of Retired Persons, among others.

The Duke University Police Department seeks two senior level managers at the rank of major. The individuals selected will be responsible for managing several operational functions that provide police, security and security support functions for Duke University and Duke University Hospital which combined encompass over 8600 acres, and 220 buildings.

One position will be operationally focused and is intended to oversee such functions as police and security operations, special events, investigations / threat assessment, etc. The second position will be support focused and is intended to oversee functions such as training, recruitment, emergency communications, records, budgeting, etc.

The Duke Police Department provides security and police services for nearly 13,000 students, 32,000 faculty and employees, over 2 million patients and countless visitors to the hundreds of special events on campus each year, including NCAA Division I athletics and community sponsored activities. The department is authorized over 60 sworn police officers and over 80 security officers. The department also consists of a 24/7 communications center and criminal investigations section.

The successful candidates will hold a minimum of a bachelor's degree, experience in progressive law enforcement leadership roles, and the ability to obtain a North Carolina Campus Police Certification in one year. The successful candidate will also demonstrate commitment to community / organization safety and issues, achieve desired results through systematic problem solving techniques, assess accurately his or her skills and goals and establish and maintain productive and collaborative interpersonal relationships. We prefer candidates with an Advanced North Carolina Law Enforcement Certificate or equivalent, a Master's Level Degree and who have completed advanced police management program, such as the FBI National Academy, Senior Management Institute for Police, etc.
